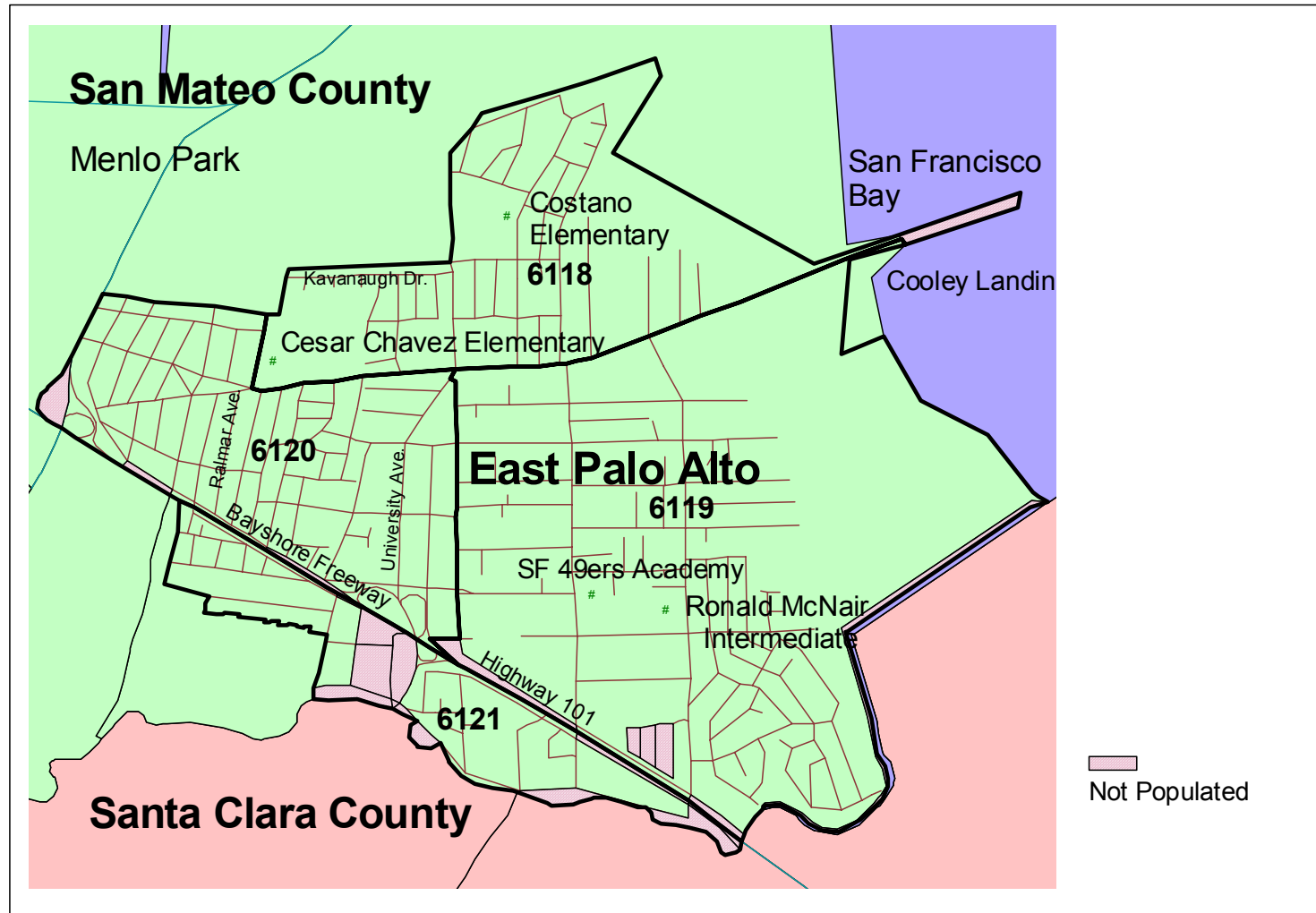
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One East Palo Alto, San Mateo County, Basic Census Tract Map (Census Tracts 2000)

Disability is defined by the census as (1) blindness, deafness, or a severe vision or hearing impairment (sensory disability), (2) a condition that substantially limits one or more basic physical activities, such as walking, climbing stairs, reaching, lifting, or carrying (physical disability), or (3) a physical, mental, or emotional condition lasting 6 months or more that made it difficult to perform certain activities such as (a) learning, remembering, or concentrating (mental disability); (b) dressing, bathing, or getting around inside the home (self-care disability); (c) going outside the home alone to shop or visit a doctor's
